Faced with the opportunity to write the design brief for the refurbishment and extension of his school, Headteacher Steve Hall was able to have a big say in how the school was designed for learning. He was also able to decide how the school would be fitted out with equipment that would encourage collaboration between staff to create an enhanced learning environment for children.

"Six months before the new buildings were opened we had to take the risk about whether or not to install interactive whiteboards in each classroom."


