




The Solution

Gary and his colleagues undertook extensive research, reviewing a number of product demonstrations. Eggbuckland College, Plymouth, which had been using Promethean boards for a while recommended them to Gary and a subsequent Promethean demonstration helped them make the final decision. The first boards purchased were installed in Geography, Science, Language and ICT departments. The installation of the boards was well received by pupils and staff alike. Following the success of the first four boards, pupils on the School Council put in a request that more Promethean ACTIVboards be invested in. Their requests were readily supported by all teachers at the school and since then Promethean ACTIVboards have been installed in every department, and the school boasts a total of 28 boards.

Gary continues: "When Promethean ACTIVboard technology launched into the education market it enabled us to move on from demonstrating and take the pupils a step further in terms of interactivity."



Benefits

Enthusiasm, both to teach and to learn has tangibly grown in the school as a direct result of the use of Promethean ACTIVboards. Gary describes the changed atmosphere: "It is encouraging to see the children eagerly interact and we can actually get them involved. Their reaction is just amazing, even the subjects that might traditionally be difficult to make dynamic are brought alive by Promethean ACTIVboards. I can recall occasions when I have seen classrooms brimming over with excitement from pupils being able to engage in such interactive learning." Staff are equally delighted at being able to inspire children with the technology. When Geography teacher, Ged Patterson and Science teacher, Mark Gambold saw what the boards were capable of instilling in children, they took it upon themselves to become fully immersed in the interactive technology and have now been drafted in by the County to act as Interactive Whiteboard teacher trainers. The Future

In the future Whitchurch plans to further invest in Promethean technology, Gary explains: "At present, we see the installation of ACTIVboards as priority but once we have an ACTIVboard in every classroom, we will consider investing in remote peripherals".

Current plans are to submit an application to become a Promethean Centre of Excellence. As a Local Centre of Excellence Whitchurch would be the main point of contact for users who wish to receive training or assessment. Their key role being to train, tutor and assess new users as well as providing a focus for the development of best practice in the use of Promethean ACTIVboards and associated software.
